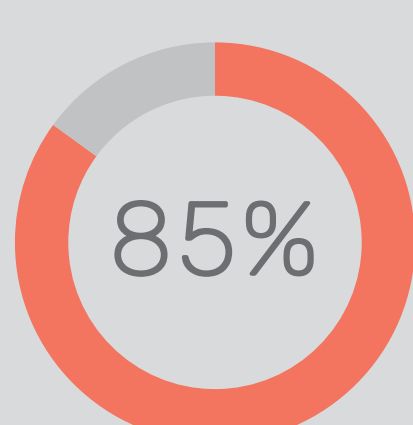
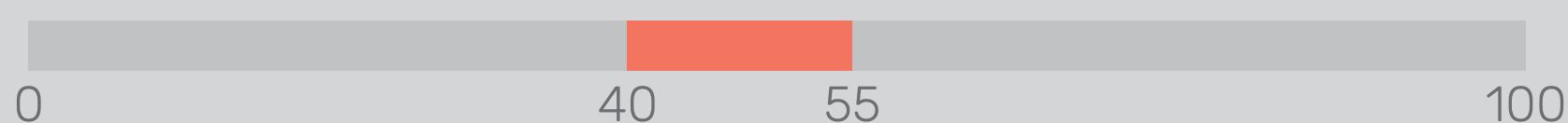


MENOPAUSAL HORMONE THERAPY (MHT) FACTS

Menopause Age Range: 40–55 (51.3 average)



Approximately **11** million women reach natural menopause each year. **85%** of these women experience some symptom related to menopause each year

PHASES



Perimenopause

Estrogen production fluctuates; periods less predictable; menopausal symptoms may arise



Menopause

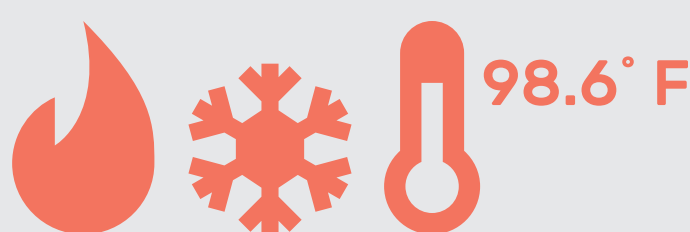
Determined by your doctor after periods have ceased for 12 months; estrogen levels continue to fall; continued symptoms



Postmenopause

Menopausal symptoms persist

Vasomotor

- Symptoms related to blood pressure and body temperature regulation
 - Hot flashes
 - Night sweats
